Liquor and beer licensing and other associated fees have not been changed in the Town of Plum Lake since 1985, 30 years ago. The Town Board is implementing an increase in those fees, which will be effective with the renewals for July of 2016. The following is a list of the current fees, the minimum and maximum fees (if any) allowed by the state and the new fees for the Town of Plum Lake. All licenses run annually from July 1 to June 30 of each year.

**Operator's (Bartender's) Licenses:** Current cost is \$5.00 for a two-year license. There is no minimum or maximum fee set by the state for operator's licenses. All applicants will be required to fill out an application form and a background check will be done on anyone who applies for an operator's license. *There will now be a delay before an operator's license will be issued.* This operator's license fee has been increased to **\$25.00 for a two-year license.**

**Cigarette licenses:** These licenses also have no state minimum or maximum. This fee is determined locally. Currently, a cigarette license fee is \$5.00. This fee will be increased to **\$25.00.**
